- Morning:** Arrive when *Dutch Wonderland*® opens at 10 AM. Start at the back of the Park and work forward throughout the day. There are rides for everyone and many rides just for kids, so look over the map. Some family fun rides are the Turtle Whirl, The Twister, Joust Family Coaster, the Kingdom Coaster and the Fun Slide.
- Lunch:** Avoid the lunch rush by eating before 11 AM or after 2 PM. Famous Famiglia® Pizza is a great family restaurant where everyone can order an individual pizza to their liking. Enjoy a refreshing after-lunch dessert from The Slush Shack or Dippin' Dots.
- Afternoon:** Spend time at the coolest spot in the Park – Duke's Lagoon! The whole family can cool off and relax! Don't miss the rides around Duke's Lagoon like the Dragon's Lair, the Sky Ride and the VR Voyager. For a midday snack, enjoy a funnel cake at the Turnpike Sweetstop.
- Evening:** Stop by the Castle Gift Shop where end of day memory items can be purchased. After exiting, located to the east of *Dutch Wonderland*, families can play an enjoyable game of mini-golf. *Wonderland*™ Mini-Golf is open late so continue the fun, check operating hours for exact times.

## Tips

- With the Two-Day Flex ticket visit *Dutch Wonderland* any two days during the summer season for \$45.95. (only \$22.98 per day!)
